Installed on the picturesque Catalina Island, this colorful fort was made to embody the culture of the island while providing imaginative play. Features include a rock climbing wall, rope net climb, mini tunnel and a two-story tower with gable roof. A curved slide completes the numerous ways on and off of the play structure.

As with all of our public play structures, an accessible transfer system allows full use of the structure.

This structure meets ASTM F1487 Standards for Public Use Playground Equipment and the 2010 Americans with Disabilities Act.

Main Tower

4' x 5' x 15' high 2-story Tower (at 6' deck height) open below, with 36" high Fortress railings above and with 4' x 5' single layered T&G Gable roof

- With hand-woven Rope Net Ladder with 2 safety handles;
- With (4) corner footing posts with metal post bases for attaching structure;
- With 4' wide x 6' high Rock Climbing wall;
- With 90° Open Slide curved to right.

ADA Accessible Transfer System

These steps provide both regular access and ADA compliant access to the upper level:

- Entry Step and Transfer platform (closed below) with Transfer Supports;
- (3) steps (closed below) with 36" high railings with handrails on 2 sides;
- Open slide with curve to right off back of transfer landing platform (4' deck height)
- Crawl tube under the platform
- (2) Step angled bridge (open below) 36" high railings with handrails on both sides.

All play structures are made from enhanced, sustainable woods and redwood lumber, construction heart grade or better, grinded smooth and then stained completely inside and out with non-toxic, tung oil stains and finished with clear tung oil as a top coat (unless otherwise specified).
